The Award

Internationalization is formally recognized as a key strategy at York University that aims to provide students with opportunities for gaining international experience and for developing the skills to function effectively in the world. The York International Award for Outstanding Contribution to Internationalization was established in the year 2000 to recognize the contribution and enhancement of the internationalization of student experience made by all areas of the York Community.

Criteria

This award will be granted to an individual or group that has demonstrated a commitment to the internationalization of student experience through one or more of the criteria listed below:

- The creation of new initiatives that contribute towards or enhance the concept of internationalization;
- The establishment of innovative approaches to internationalizing the student experience;
- Outstanding service to the international student community and/or service in internationalizing the student experience;
- Excellence in internationalized programming in either a formal academic or extra-curricular setting;

Eligibility

The award is open to all individuals and groups that have made a positive contribution to the York community. An awards committee comprised of representatives from York International will determine up to four (4) recipients of this award each year. The committee aims to present one award to a member or group from each of the following categories:

- York Student or student group
- 2. York Faculty member or Faculty
- 3. York Staff member or department
- 4. External community member or group

Nominations for this award may be made by any member of the York Community. To make a nomination, please fill out the accompanying nomination form and submit it to the York International office no later than 4:30pm on Friday February 29th, 2008.
