  - o Best undergraduate submission: \$1000
- Winning essays will be selected by a panel appointed by the President of the Hall Foundation.
- Winning essays will be posted on the Hall Foundation website and displayed at a
  poster session organized by the Hall Foundation at the Annual Canadian
  Association for Health Services and Policy Research Conference.
