- Essays should be up to 3000 words long (excluding references and appendices) and address any topic in health services or health policy.
- The Hall Foundation will award three prizes annually for the best submissions
 - Best doctoral submission \$1500
 - Best masters submission: \$1250
 - Best undergraduate submission: \$1000
- Winning essays will be selected by a panel appointed by the President of the Hall Foundation.
- Winning essays will be posted on the Hall Foundation website and displayed at a poster session organized by the Hall Foundation at the Annual Canadian Association for Health Services and Policy Research Conference.

 - University
 - Department and program of enrolment
 - Program coordinator and contact information
 - 3000 word essay
