Research Symposium – Integrative Approaches to Health

1. Include your name and area of study
2. E-mail address & phone number (mobile)
3. Title & abstract not exceeding 250 words.
4. Plan for a 15 minute presentation, + 5 minutes of Q & A

A symposium schedule and location will be promoted and posted on the GRASP website (www.yorku.ca/grasp). Acceptance letters will be sent within 3 weeks after the deadline for submission (February 13th, 2015).

Audio and video equipment will be provided at the symposium for the presenters using PowerPoint presentations. Refreshments, lunch, and beverage will be served. Attendance will be open to all students, faculty, and staff at York at no charge.
