## ***Copyright Escapades***

*Copyright can be fun!!*

Join us for an evening of copyright fun playing a game of Copyright Escapades. The game uses a special deck of cards designating roles (e.g., creator, researcher, student, etc.), tasks (copying the created work for various purposes), copyright licences (creative commons licences that specify the conditions under which the work may be used), and voting cards (is your choice of licence appropriate for your use). Each player receives a one-page summary of the relevant provisions of Canadian copyright law to assist them in their decisions.

The games-master will be Jean Dryden, assisted by Hujma Chowdhury from the Copyright Office at the University of Toronto. Jean is a well-known copyright educator who has presented scores of workshops on copyright to archivists, librarians, and educators.

Participants will have an opportunity to:

- Unleash their inner artist as they create/adapt artistic works
- (Possibly) infringe copyright in a safe environment
- Consider what license to apply to artistic works created by themselves or colleagues.
- Vote on whether the adapted works infringe copyright
- Discuss the results of the vote
