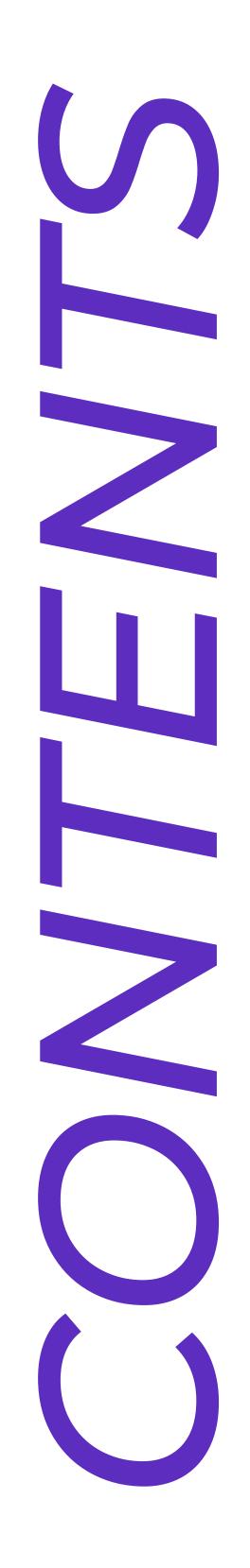

THE FIRST CANADIAN POLICYTHON ———

What's a Policython? This event combines the educational insight offered by simulations, the fast-paced nature of hackathons and the issue-focused challenge of case competitions to allow students in government and advocacy to tackle real-world policy issues that Canada faces in Human Rights, Foreign, Public Health, and Environmental Policy. By the end of the event, participants will have created a policy brief to be judged by experts and potentially awarded.

POLICYTHON 2024

Our annual event offers university students an opportunity to get creative and interact with real public policy and current events. Between March 7-10, participants will be challenged to write policy briefs responding to a given prompt in the field of their choice, which they present to judges at the **University of Toronto St. George Campus** and are then potentially awarded.

We support student efforts through workshops and fireside chats, and foster the Policython community through social events during the Policython weekend.

For the second time, we welcome students from McMaster, York, and TMU back to compete and learn from direct input by political experts and community leaders.

While still deciding on this year's themes, some of the questions we seek to address include: How can we, as youth, make our communities better? What can the government do to uplift its citizens? What would <u>you</u> do?
